Internet Use Policy for United States Government Documents in the Drake University Law Library

The Drake University Law Library's Government Documents department is committed to providing unimpeded access, at no cost, to information emanating from Federal government agencies, in accordance with the guidelines and requirements of the Federal Depository Library Program. This service will be available not only to the library's primary clientele, the faculty and students of the Drake University Law School, but also to members of the general public.

In order to fulfill the above mission of service as a Depository Library, the Law School provides equal access for all patrons to the increasing array of Federal agency resources available via the Internet using the following guidelines:

- Free access to Internet resources is available to all users via personal computers located on the Library's main level;
- There are no fees for use of the computers (other than standard printing fees paid by all Library patrons);
- There are no age or status restrictions to computer use;
- The Law Library uses no filtering software to restrict Internet access.
- Reference assistance is provided for all users of Federal electronic resources upon request;

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Law Librarians.
