More Frequent Snow Removal

Beginning this year, all residential streets Citywide will be plowed after 2" snowfalls. Previously, most residential streets were plowed only on snowfalls of greater than 4".

Alleys

This year alleys providing access to residential properties will be plowed prior to the end of a snowfall to facilitate off-street parking during street snow plowing operations.

Odd/ Even Side Snow Parking

On-street parking is restricted Citywide. Five neighborhoods are included in the odd/even side snow parking program. These neighborhoods are: Carpenter, Drake, Drake Park, River Bend, and Sherman Hill. If you cannot move your vehicle off the street in these five neighborhoods, parking will alternate on both sides of the street during snow plowing operations to allow the use of large wing plow equipment to clear the streets of snow and ice.

On odd number dates vehicles, must park on the side of the street with odd numbered houses (the north & east side of the street). On even numbered dates, vehicles must park on the side of the street with even numbered houses (the south & west side of the street). Vehicles must be on the correct side by 7 AM.

Snow operations will take place from 7 AM to 7 PM in your neighborhood to facilitate the movement of vehicles

Enforcement

Residents are expected to follow parking restrictions during snow plowing operations. Warnings will be issued by police on the first two storms only. After that, vehicle's owner will be ticketed and/or towed. The cost of a ticket is \$35.

NEW PARKING ORDINANCE IN EFFECT THIS SNOW SEASON

Odd/Even Side Snow Parking Rules

- If possible, move your car off of the street completely.
- Park on the ODD house numbered side of the street on odd numbered days from 7 AM to 7 PM
- Park on the EVEN house numbered side of the street on even numbered days from 7 AM to 7 PM
- Failure to move vehicles to correct side of the street during snow plowing operations will result in a \$35 fine and possible towing.
