## **Point System Criteria**

All drivers who are required under Drake University policy to pass a motor vehicle record (MVR) check to drive on behalf of the University or as part of a University-sponsored event **must have less than six points.** Any driver who is required to pass a University MVR check that has six or more points is considered a "High Risk Driver" and may not drive on behalf of the University including group trip driving or driving as an essential job function until their accumulated points drop to less than six points. Exceptions for situations in which an individual required under University policy to pass a MVR check will drive their personal vehicle and their personal vehicle insurance coverage applies will be considered on a case-by-case basis and will be dependent upon circumstances of the violations and total points accumulated.

An individual's accumulated points are calculated over the most current five-year period for major violations and over the most current three-year period for minor violations. Following is a list of major and minor moving violations and the points assigned to each:

Drake University reserves the right to classify any driver as a high-risk driver based on any accidents, violations or other behaviors within the most current twelve-month period which cause the supervisor to determine the driver presents a high risk.
