## Ports of Call

### **NAPLES/CAPRI, ITALY**

Enjoy the day exploring the fabulous ruins of ancient Pompeii or Herculaneum with their stunning temples, frescoes and mosaics. Explore fascinating Naples and its famed museums, visit charming Sorrento or take a boat trip to the beautiful Isle of Capri.

### **OLBIA/PORTO CERVO (SARDINIA), ITALY**

Wander through the lovely town of Olbia and visit its 11th-century cathedral with Roman artifacts and Punic burials. Or drive into the stunningly beautiful countryside of the Costa Smeralda with its towering cliffs, quiet grottoes and exquisite sandy beaches beside emerald green waters. Explore the enigmatic remnants of the ancient Nuragic culture.

### **LA SPEZIA (CINQUE TERRE), ITALY**

Discover the five stunning, colorful towns clinging to the cliffs along the coast. Take a boat tour to see them from the water as ancient seafarers did, and go ashore and explore one of the picturesque towns. Or visit intriguing Portovenere, another colorful town rising above one end of La Spezia's harbor with breathtaking views and the lovely Church of San Pietro.

### **FLORENCE/PISA (LIVORNO), ITALY**

Explore the fabled architecture of Renaissance Florence: the Duomo with Brunelleschi's dome, the Baptistery, Michelangelo's *David*, the bridge over the Arno and the Uffizi Gallery. Visit Pisa's superb Field of Miracles and the iconic Leaning Tower. Or lose yourself in the Tuscan countryside and the towns of Siena, and San Gimignano renowned for its medieval towers.

### **AJACCIO (CORSICA), FRANCE**

Stroll through the narrow streets of Napoleon's birthplace, visit the bustling, colorful market, browse in the shops and see the Cathedral where he was baptized. Relax in shady Place Foch beside a bubbling fountain and Napoleon's statue. Or discover the stunning, rugged Corsican countryside and its famous aromatic maquis shrubs and oak trees. Admire the superb views and the impressive Prunelli Gorges.

### **MONTE CARLO, MONACO**

Take in sparkling Monaco as you drive along the famous Grand Corniche, then stroll through the old quarter. See the pink palace of the Grimaldi family, visit the Casino, explore the Côte d'Azur from Nice to Cannes, Grasse and the lovely St. Paul de Vence, each a jewel to savor.

### **PROVENCE (MARSEILLE), FRANCE**

See the sights and enjoy the views of historic old Marseille and visit the charming fishing port of Cassis. Or venture into the celebrated Provençal countryside and explore lovely Aix or stroll through Avignon and see the Papal Palace, the famed bridge and the hilltop village of Les Baux.

### **SÈTE, FRANCE**

Spend a glorious day in the Provençal countryside, seeing magnificent Carcassonne with its towers, turrets, half-timbered houses and superb nave of the 11th-century Basilica de Saint-Nazaire, beautiful hilltop Les Baux or Arles, where Van Gogh found so much inspiration. Or explore fortified Aigues Mortes, in the heart of the Petite Camargue, surrounded by ponds, marshes and salt pans.

### **PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN**

Explore this beautiful island beginning with the magnificent Cathedral and Bellver Castle. See the windmills and impressive manor house in the verdant countryside. Discover the amazing natural wonders in the Drach Caves. And for romance, visit the former Carthusian Monastery in Valdemosa where George Sand and Chopin spent a winter.
