<p align="center">Hood Cleaning Procedures (Student is able to clean hoods properly each time and knows which materials can/can not be used)</p>			
<p align="center">Disposal of needle and syringe (Student observes proper recapping of syringes and proper disposal of all products)</p>			
<p align="center">Reconstituting powders (Student observes the steps necessary to reconstitute powders and how this differs from liquids)</p>			
<p align="center">Drawing up fluid from glass ampoule (Student is able to identify when to use filter needles and straws and their proper use)</p>			
<p align="center">Adding medication to an IV bag (Student observes the proper technique of adding medications to IV bags (including epidurals and cassettes)</p>			
<p align="center">Overall Sterile Technique (Student demonstrates consistent good sterile technique while in hood-proper swabbing, positioning of vials, 6" rule)</p>
