Duties include collaborating with other DULAP faculty, choosing course materials and developing syllabi for Spanish courses; training and mentoring native-speaking Language Partners; monitoring student practice sessions and coaching Spanish students. Additional duties may include teaching, preparing presentations for conferences, developing or adapting language-specific course materials for use online. May contribute courses to interdisciplinary programs.
