
Financial Privacy in the United States

Federal Corporate Transparency Act

- Reporting entitles make less than \$5 million in annual sales and have fewer than 20 employees
- To the extent that an owner owns 25% or more of an entity that is required to report beneficial owners must report
 beneficial owners' full legal name


 - current residential or business street address
