Summer Financial Aid

- Complete 2023 2024 FAFSA at fafsa.gov
- Enroll in at least 5 credit hours.
- Enroll in other summer and fall classes.



- Watch for award notification email from financialaid@drake.edu.
- At the bottom of the award notification there is a link to instructions to accept/apply for and decline loans.



Types of Aid Available

- Scholarships
 - Check with Law admission/financial aid office
- Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan
- Federal Direct Grad PLUS loan
- Your award notification will encompass summer, fall and spring with the eligible aid available in each term.



Important

- All deposits for abroad trips must be paid out of pocket.
- Your financial aid for this program is not available until after the first day of summer term(May 16, 2023). Earliest day funds will disburse.
- Set up direct deposit if you haven't already.
- Complete all requirements prior to departure.
- Funds applied to Drake bill and then the remainder refunded to your personal account.









Important

- Be prepared as funds may not show up in your personal account immediately depending on timing of fund transfer.
- Maximum Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan for Award Year is \$20,500.
- Summer borrowing impacts Fall/Spring.
- Federal Grad PLUS loan has no set annual maximum award. It is Cost of Attendance – other aid awarded.

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan

- Requires entrance counseling & master promissory note.
- Access Financial Aid in Self-Service.
- Under Home section respond to the required question.
- Under the Award Offer section, accept Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan.



Federal Direct Grad PLUS Loan for Fall/Spring

- Apply after April 15 at https://studentaid.gov
- Requires entrance counseling & master promissory note.
- Must be Credit Worthy
- If denied, information will be presented to you for endorser information.
