Student Academic Accommodation for Flexibility with Attendance Request

The Student Disability Services office recognizes that attendance in courses varies widely and the information below has been communicated to the student:

- Each class/faculty has different attendance policies which may or may not be flexible
- Lab, discussion, group work and hands-on courses involve in-class learning that cannot be easily made up
- Some classes due to their structure may be able to provide more flexibility than other classes

Student Understanding:

- If I am approved for flexible attendance, I am still responsible for meeting all of the requirements of the class.
- If I am approved for flexible attendance, I understand it is not a free pass — any absences must be related to my qualifying condition and must be communicated to my instructor.
- I have discussed the following with my instructor and understand (please check the items discussed):
 - The parameters and expectations of the course, including participation requirements; The attendance policy and if there are exceptions
 - Whether there is a limit to the number of classes I can miss; Whether missing class compromises the progress of the group and/or class
 - Whether I am permitted to make up work, quizzes, or exams missed due to my qualifying condition and how I may make it up
 - How I should communicate and when I should communicate to the instructor if I need to miss class
