 - 1. Allowing adjuncts/students to check out laptops for classroom use.
 - a. Attempting to phase out classroom computers

 - a. New Course Proposals
 - i. Art 081, BIO 196, LPS 031, LPS 131 unanimously approved. ART 177 tabled.
 - 1. Art 081-why is the cap so low? Other courses in Art have similar caps due to materials/space
 - 2. Art 177-why is the cap at 12? There is already another course with same number-course tabled for further discussion with Art Department
 - 3. LPS 131-can it be limited to just LPS majors for the first part or registration? Vice Council chair says yes, since upper level course

 - i. ART 145/HONR 194-unanimously approved
 - Note from Curriculum Committee-given an Art number even though not an Art class because it needed an A&S number and professor teaching is from Art department

 - i. Increase current capstone to 3 credits
 - ii. Increase total credit hours for major to 43 credits needed.

 - i. Would like to have a college-sponsored book on diversity for faculty, with discussion led by Diversity Committee, as it fits with current initiatives.
