Stat 71 - An introduction to descriptive and inferential statistics; frequency distributions; measures of central tendency and spread; confidence intervals; large and small sample tests of significance; probability; and binomial and normal distributions.

Stat 72 - Continuance of STAT 071 with further tests of significance; analysis of variance; correlation and regression; control charts; and contingency table analysis.

Acts 131 - An introduction to probability concepts, including definition of probability; independence; conditional probability; random variables; specific discrete and continuous probability distributions; multivariate random variables; moments and moment generating functions; functions of random variables; sampling distributions; and central limit theorem.

Acts 131L – A lab for Acts 131. Extra problem solving and practice.

Acts 120 - Measurement of interest; solution of interest problems; basic and general annuities; yield rates; amortization schedules and sinking funds; bonds; yield curves; duration and immunization; stochastic approaches, derivatives and their use in managing risk. (This class used to be Acts 140, a 4-credit course.)

Acts 150 - Present value determination for life insurances and annuities; benefit premiums and reserves.

Acts 151 - Multiple life functions, multiple decrement models; applications to pension plans, insurance models including expenses.
