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Summary

Alanah Mitchell is the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs and Aliber Distinguished Professor of Information Systems in the Zimpleman College of Business at Drake University. She earned her Ph.D. in Information Technology (IT) from the University of Nebraska at Omaha. Alanah's research focuses on the design, implementation, and use of information and communication technologies for collaboration, specifically in global virtual teams. Additionally, she researches in the areas of e-commerce and information systems (IS) pedagogy. Alanah has published in premier outlets such as *Communications of the Association for Information Systems*, *DATA BASE for Advances in Information Systems*, *Electronic Markets*, *Information Technology and People*, *Journal of the Association for Information Systems*, and *Organizational Dynamics* as well as others.
