



IPA Committee Opportunities

IPA Policy Committees

Policy Committees serve to move an idea or concept into official IPA policy to provide direction for the Association and the profession. The two committees analyze current professional and public issues and recommend policy statements to the House of Delegates, which then discusses and votes on the statements that will become official policy of the Association.

IPA Advisory Committees

- *Advisory Committee on Medicaid & Pharmacy Benefit Programs*

This committee discusses issues related to the delivery of services in the Iowa Medicaid program and the state's fiscal intermediary. This committee has expanded its scope to encompass Medicare Part D and issues pertaining to third party payers and pharmacy benefits managers.

- *Education Programming Advisory Committee*

Newly formed in 2014, this committee will assist IPA and the Collaborative Education Institute (CEI) in delivery of educational programs to IPA members across the state.

- *Health-System Liaison Board (HSLB)*

Established in 2007, this committee advises the Board of Trustees to address the needs of hospital and health-system pharmacists in the state. The HSLB is chaired by a health-system pharmacist on the IPA Executive Committee.

- *Iowa Pharmacy Political Action Committee (IPPAC) Advisory Committee*

Established in 2012, this committee promotes the pharmacy profession in the Iowa political arena through direct strategic support of electoral politics. Each committee member must be an annual contributor to the IPPAC with a \$250 minimum contribution.

- *Legislative Advisory Committee*

The broad responsibilities assigned to this committee are the following: 1) to review legislative and regulatory proposals affecting the profession of pharmacy in Iowa, 2) to review and evaluate legislative proposals emanating from other states as well as pertinent federal initiatives, and 3) to recommend a list of legislative and regulatory priorities to the Board of Trustees.

- *Long-Term Care & Senior Care Advisory Committee*

Established in 2011, this committee provides guidance on issues that include, but not limited to: short cycle dispensing, geriatric therapy updates, and federal rule updates related to LTC and Senior Care.

- *Pharmacy Technician Advisory Committee*

This group addresses current issues facing pharmacy technician members. The committee promotes national pharmacy technician certification examination in Iowa, and develops and promotes programs and educational materials for CPhTs and technicians interested in becoming certified.

Other Opportunities

- *Golf Classic Planning Committee*

Established in 2012, this committee develops and implements strategies for a successful Eggleston-Granberg Golf Classic. All proceeds of this annual event provide scholarships for student pharmacists from the Colleges of Pharmacy in Iowa.

- *RAGBRAI Planning Committee*

Established in 2013, this committee develops and implements strategies for a successful IPA Foundation team at the Register's Annual Great Bicycle Ride Across Iowa (RAGBRAI) held every July. All proceeds support the general fund for IPA-F.

- *Iowa Pharmacy Recovery Network (IPRN) Mentor*

IPRN is a monitoring and advocacy peer-review program for the purpose of assisting impaired pharmacy professionals, including pharmacists, pharmacy students and pharmacy technicians, whose dependency and/or disability is potentially threatening to professional performance and public safety. IPRN volunteers may assist in monitoring impaired professionals for compliance with their IPRN contract as well as providing peer support and assistance to impaired professionals as they enter treatment and recovery.
