There might be a line to get into the bathroom



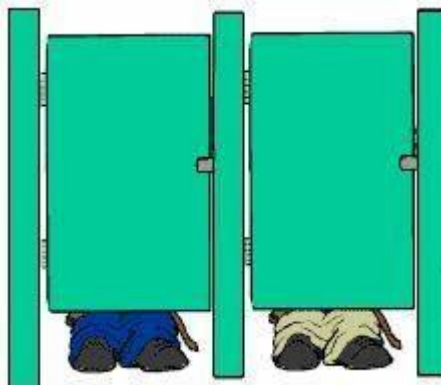
The bathroom looks different than at home, but my mom can help me find an empty stall.

I will go inside the stall and close the door.



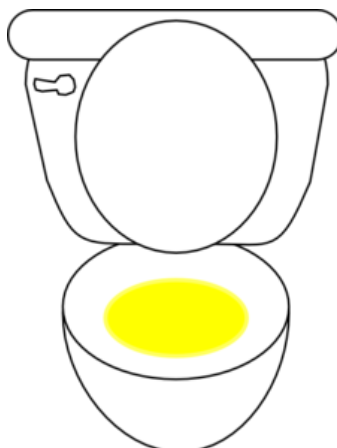
I will pull my pants down.



I will sit on the toilet.



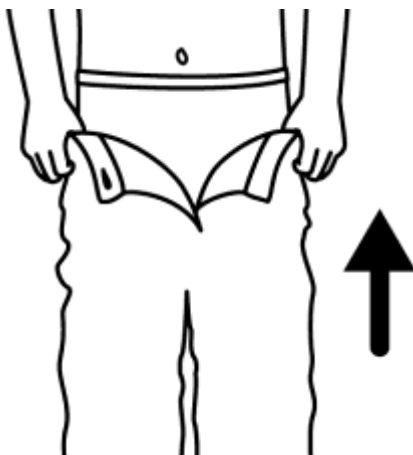
I will pee or poop in the potty.



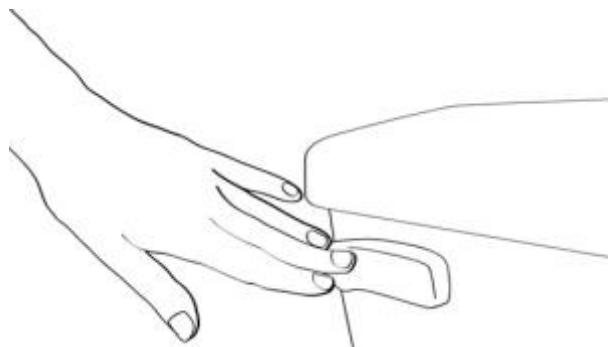
I will wipe my bottom, and when I am finished, I will put it in the toilet.
