Pay Seat Deposit

Submit Final Transcripts

All students must ensure that a final transcript from their degree-granting institution is on file with LSAC or sent directly to Drake Law School. The transcript must note the completion date of the baccalaureate degree.

Immunization Requirements

Every student is required to submit a health history and immunization form by the second week of classes, or a hold will be placed on your registration status. To download a form, visit www.drake.edu/health/policiesandforms/. Your completed form must be returned to the Student Health Center by mail, fax or email as instructed on the form.

Section Assignments

The Law School will handle your registration for first-year courses. You will receive a series of emails in the weeks prior to your enrollment containing important information related to your course schedule, book requirements, student portal log-in instructions and orientation. Please notify the Office of Admission if your email address changes.

Orientation
