- 1. The course must be a graduate level or an upper division course offered at Drake University.
- 2. The course must be materially relevant to the student's educational program and goals.
- 3. The academic advisor must approve the granting of interdisciplinary credit by signing below.
- 4. The Associate Dean must approve the granting of interdisciplinary credit by signing below.

Grades from these courses are not counted in the Law School cumulative GPA. If a C+ or better is earned, you will receive credit hours for approved interdisciplinary course(s).
