### Motion SS [190905] - E: Board of Student Communications, Removal of *The Annual*

To remove *The Annual* magazine from the Board of Student Communications in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Drake University Student Senate.

1. Whereas, it is within the scope of the Student Senate to vote on matters related to the Board of Student Communications;
2. Whereas, any decision regarding the approval of a publication must also be approved by Faculty Senate and the Board of Student Communications itself;
3. Whereas, student interest in *The Annual* has declined in recent years, leading to a lack of active staff members and forcing the magazine to cease publication;
4. Whereas, *The Annual* has not received applications for its editor-in-chief position for the last two academic years, rendering it eligible for removal under the bylaws of the Board of Student Communications;
5. Whereas, the removal will ensure a more streamlined budgeting process for the remaining publications and broadcasts under the Board of Student Communications.

Now, therefore, be it

*Moved.* That *The Annual* be removed from the Board of Student communications, pending votes of approval from the Faculty Senate and the Board of Student Communications.
