Amendment to Section C of the Faculty Senate Rules and Regulations following the Faculty Senate Representation Resolution passed October 2018. Please see the Background document for more information. The text in **red** below represents additions to section C of the “Faculty Senate Rules and Regulations” document to accommodate the proposed amendment.

*C. At-Large Senators.*

**1. Generally.** *Four Senators of the Faculty of Instruction will be elected by a University-wide At-Large election (At-Large Senators) from the list of eligible candidates prepared under (II)(C)(4). No more than one At-Large Senator can be elected from each Unit.*

**2. Units.** *For electing At-Large Senators, each of the following is considered a Unit:*

- a. Cowles Library;*
- b. the Law School;*
- c. the School of Journalism and Mass Communication;*
- d. the School of Education;*
- e. the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences;*
- f. the College of Business and Public Administration;*
- g. the College of Arts and Sciences, the Division of Humanities;*
- h. the College of Arts and Sciences, the Division of Natural Sciences;*
- i. the College of Arts and Sciences, the Division of Social Sciences;*
- j. the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Fine Arts.*

**3. Term and Election.** *At-Large Senators will be elected to two-year terms.*
