<b>What is the overall <u>deductible</u>?</b>	In- <u>Network</u> (IN) <u>Provider</u> : <b>\$1,000</b> person/ <b>\$2,000</b> family per calendar year. Out-of- <u>Network</u> (OON) <u>Provider</u> : <b>\$2,500</b> person/ <b>\$5,000</b> family per calendar year.	Generally, you must pay all the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u>?</b>	Yes. Well-child care, <u>preventive care</u> from your designated personal doctor, in- <u>network</u> independent labs/routine vision exams, vision hardware, <u>prescription drugs</u> , independent labs for mental health/substance abuse services and services subject to <u>copayments</u> . This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the <u>provider's</u> charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays ( <u>balance billing</u> ). Be aware, your <u>network provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.
