**Deadline to register via Qualtrics and sign up for a time: Wednesday October 30, 2024 at noon.**
  - **You are required to register prior to signing up for an audition time.**

  - The Drake Student Honors Recital Auditions will be held on Sunday **November 3, 2024**
    - FAC 004-Monroe 1-2pm for percussionists
    - 2:15-5pm in Sheslow Auditorium for all other competitors.
  - NOTE: You must complete the registration form in Qualtrics **prior** to signing up for an audition time slot. \*Those who sign up for a slot but do not complete registration will be removed from the audition sign-up sheet.\*
    - **Online registration closes Wednesday Oct. 30, 2024 at noon.**
  - Total audition performance time will not exceed 7 minutes; slots are 10 minutes long to allow for stage changes and for tuning. Participants will be expected to perform one or two movements (more for brief compositions) of a work at the audition. Both solo and chamber ensembles are encouraged to audition, after consulting with their teacher/coach. Students may audition for the Honors recital competition on two different instruments in the same competition but may only be accepted as a winner for **one solo** performance. Students may be accepted as a winner as **both solo and ensemble** performer. Previous winners of the Music Department Honors Recital Competition may compete in subsequent years.
  - Soloists are responsible for accompanist fees for the audition as outlined by the Drake University Department of Music. Pianist fees for the February performance are covered by the department.
  - For the recital, you may only perform music that is listed in your registration. You may change this information *up until the registration deadline (Oct. 30th) for the competition*. Judges will select recital repertoire based on the audition: **the February 7, 2025 performance must be the same repertoire with which you audition.**
  - Judges are Drake music faculty and area professional musicians. The criterion for selection to the Student Honors Recital is a performance of outstanding quality.
  - Selected soloists and chamber ensembles will be featured on the Drake Music Department Student Honors Recital scheduled for **Friday, February 7, 2025 at 7:30 PM** on the Jordan Stage-Sheslow Auditorium. You must be able to perform on this concert to audition.
