

Phi Delta Chi History

On November 2, 1883, in Ann Arbor Michigan, a group of 11 men, each students at the University of Michigan College of Pharmacy, realizing a need for an association of professional students in the field of pharmacy and chemistry, founded the Phi Chi pharmacy fraternity. A change in the Fraternity's name to Phi Delta Chi occurred in 1909 after conflict with a pre-existing medical Fraternity.

Phi Delta Chi was established on strong ideals of service, scholastic development, and professionalism. Phi Delta Chi's objective is to advance the science of pharmacy and its allied interests, and to foster and promote a fraternal spirit among its members.

Phi Delta Chi's endurance, since its inception, is due to unwavering national and local traditions which have been passed down from generation to generation of Brothers. Prospective Brothers learn the principles and precepts of the Fraternity and embody them throughout their lives as contributing members of the pharmacy community.
