### WHAT IS COMPOSTABLE?

Produce such as fruits and vegetables

Paper products such as cups, plates, napkins, etc

Compostable dinnerware



Meat scraps and spoiled meat

Eggs and dairy products

Flowers



Cardboard including waxed cardboard

Coffee grounds and the filters



Dry goods such as crackers, bread, candy, etc



### WHAT IS NOT COMPOSTABLE?

Plastic and plastic lined items



Metal



Glass



Styrofoam

Ceramics
